

A community dashboard to enable monitoring of local health indicators.

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Project proposal

Overview

In today's data-informed landscape, the ability to track, analyze, and visualize health and wellbeing indicators is vital for making informed decisions, improving public health, and addressing critical healthcare challenges. However, making these data accessible, updated and available to the important stakeholders and decision makers remains a challenge in many sectors. This proposal outlines the development and pilot implementation of a Health Indicator Data Dashboard for the Michiana region that will be informed by, and designed with, the Health Improvement Alliance of St. Joseph County (HIA), a cross-industry group of health and social-service providers working to reduce redundancies in health programs.

Designed to serve as a comprehensive platform for monitoring and interpreting health data, the primary goal of this proposal is to provide a clear and comprehensive plan for creating a Health Indicator Data Dashboard that will enable healthcare professionals, researchers, non-profit organizations and policymakers to access, analyze, and understand health-related data efficiently. This dashboard will facilitate evidence-based decision-making, enhance healthcare planning, and contribute to the overall well-being of the population, while leaving both organizations more competitive for additional funding.
